

Neolithic and Earlier Bronze Age

- **PRN** - (Unique reference number) for relevant site and event records in the regional HER (Historic Environment Record)
- **NGR** – National Grid reference
- **SM number** – Scheduled Monument number, if appropriate
- **NPRN** – Unique reference number in NMR (National Monuments Record) held by the RCAHMW (Royal Commission on the Ancient and Historical Monuments in Wales)
